

ASA TOURNAMENT RULES

FOR 2009 QUALIFIERS



- 1 The ASA Official Playing Rules will be the rules for the tournament.
2. All teams must be registered with ASA.
3. **EACH TEAM MUST CHECK IN WITH EACH PLAYER AT LEAST ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THEIR FIRST GAME TIME FOR INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION. EACH PLAYER MUST HAVE HER INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION CARD WITH HER. THERE WILL BE SOMEONE AVAILABLE TO CHECK IN YOUR TEAM 1 AND 1/2 HOUR BEFORE GAME TIME IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE THERE EARLY.**
4. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ORIGINAL 2009 ASA ROSTER AT CHECK IN. THIS ROSTER MUST BE ONE ONE SHEET OF PAPER BACK AND FRONT. WE WILL SIGN THEM AT THE TOURNAMENT. THERE CANNOT BE ANY PICK UP PLAYERS FOR QUALIFIERS, ONCE THE PLAYER SIGNS IN WITH YOUR TEAM THEN SHE IS FROZEN TO YOUR ROSTER FOR THE SEASON AND CANNOT BE RELEASED.**
5. **There must one ACE certified coach/manager on the field at all times with each team. The coach/manager must have their ACE card with them at check in.**
- 6 Each team must furnish one new ASA Junior Olympic approved 12in optic yellow leather covered softball for each game in which they participate.
- 7 Teams must be on the field and ready to play at the scheduled game time or the game will be subject to forfeit. There will not be a grace period.
- 8 No inning shall start after one hour and 30 minutes, unless the game is tied. In case of a tie the ASA tie breaker rule will be utilized beginning at the top of the next inning.
- 9 All protests will be settled by a protest committee made up of three representatives from the Tournament Committee. A protest fee of \$150.00 (one hundred fifty dollars) cash, will be required the time the protest is filed. If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be returned; if the protest is denied, the fee shall be forfeited. All decisions of the protest committee are final.
- 10 No infield practice will be allowed at any time.
- 11 Home team will be determined by a coin toss prior to each game at home plate during the pre-game conference with the umpires. Official time will be kept by the official score keeper.
- 12 Line ups must be given to the official scorekeeper, located above the concession stand, no later than fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
- 13 In case of rain, the schedule is subject to modification by the Tournament Committee to insure the completion of the tournament. It shall be the managers/coaches responsibility to stay in touch with the tournament committee in case of scheduling disruptions. (irrespective of the number of games played.)
- 14 If an age group reaches fifteen in number then the championship game will not be played.
- 15 Team trophies will be awarded to the top two teams in each division and Individual awards will be awarded to the top two teams.
