



GEORGIA ISF YOUTH WORLD CUP 16 AND UNDER A QUALIFIER

- 1 **The ASA 2010 Official Playing Rules will be the rules for the tournament.**
- 2 **All teams must be individual registered with ASA.**
- 3 **EACH TEAM MUST CHECK IN WITH EACH PLAYER AT LEAST ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THEIR FIRST GAME TIME FOR INDIVIDUAL CHECK IN. EACH PLAYER MUST HAVE HER INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION CARD WITH HER. THERE WILL BE SOMEONE AVAILABLE TO CHECK IN YOUR TEAM 1 AND 1/2 HOUR BEFORE GAME TIME IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE THERE EARLY.**
- 4 **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ORIGINAL 2010 CHAMPIONSHIP ASA ROSTER AT CHECK IN. (this is the roster that has a column for the parents to sign and a column for them to int. If your roster is not a championship please call me and I will set it for a championship roster.) THIS ROSTER MUST BE ON ONE SHEET OF PAPER BACK AND FRONT. THE MANAGER SHOULD SIGN THE BACK, PARENTS SHOULD SIGN AND INITIAL THE FRONT BY THE PLAYERS NAME. HAVE THIS COMPLETED BEFORE YOU COME TO CHECK IN. EACH PLAYER MUST SIGN THE BACK OF THEIR CARD BEFORE COMING TO CHECK IN. (Be sure to sign it with a Sharpie Permanent Marker, so it will not rub off.) THREE PICK-UP PLAYERS WILL BE ALLOWED. THESE PLAYERS MUST GO ON A PICK UP PLAYER FORM WHICH CAN BE DOWNLOADED FROM THE GEORGIAASAS.COM WEB SITE. THESE FORMS SHOULD BE SIGNED BY THE PARENTS AND TURNED IN AT CHECK IN. ALL PICK UP PLAYERS MUST COME FROM A SIXTEEN AND UNDER OR LOWER TEAM THAT IS NOT GOING TO THE SOUTHERN NATIONAL OR ASA/USA NATIONAL. REGISTERED WITH GEORGIA ASA.**
- 5 **ANYONE ONE ON THE FIELD WITH THE TEAM MUST HAVE COMPLETED THE BACKGROUND CHECK AND ACE FOR 2010. EACH COACH SHOULD CHECK IN WITH TEAM TO SHOW HIS BACKGROUND/ACE CARD. THE COACH MUST HAVE THE CARD ON WHILE ON THE FIELD.**
- 7 **Teams must be on the field and ready to play at the scheduled game time or the game will be subject to forfeit. There will not be a grace period.**
- 8 **No inning shall start after one hour and 40 minutes, unless the game is tied. In case of a tie the ASA tie breaker rule will be utilized beginning at the top of the next inning. GAMES WHICH BERTHS ARE AWARDED THERE WILL BE NO TIME LIMIT. THESE ARE GAMES 11 AND 13.**
- 9 **All protests will be settled by a protest committee made up of three representatives from the Tournament Committee. A protest fee of \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) cash, will be required the time the protest is filed. If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be returned; if the protest is denied, the fee shall be forfeited. All decisions of the protest committee are final.**
- 10 **No infield practice will be allowed at any time.**
- 11 **Home team will be determined by a coin toss prior to each game at home plate during the pre-game conference with the umpires. Official time will be kept by the official score keeper.**

- 12 Line ups must be given to the official scorekeeper, located above the concession stand, no later than fifteen (15) minutes prior to the scheduled game time.
- 13 In case of rain, the schedule is subject to modification by the Tournament Committee to insure the completion of the tournament. It shall be the managers/coaches responsibility to stay in touch with the tournament committee in case of scheduling disruptions. (irrespective of the number of games played.)
- 14 Team trophies will be awarded to the top two teams in each division.
