Ernie Parker has been coaching and giving pitching lessons for about 30 years. He coached and worked with one of the all time top elite travel teams in California, the Gordon Panthers, where he won 9 ASA National Championships at all levels. During that time, he also taught pitchers from other travel teams who also won national championships. He has also worked with All-Americans at many top universities including UCLA, Arizona, Arizona State, Stanford, Ohio State, Notre Dame, Michigan, Michigan State, Florida State, Cal State Long Beach, Harvard, Tennessee, Cal State Fullerton, and many others.

Coach Parker has instructed pitchers in places such as Peru, Canada, Taipei China, Mainland China, Spain, Holland, Hawaii, Alaska, and Italy.

Information and Registration Form

This clinic will feature hands on instruction from Coach Parker and the Emory Clinic staff breaking down ALL aspects of pitching from beginner, to intermediate, and advance. All students will be taught or skill advancement of proper spin, form, and technique of the curve, drop, change, screw and Coach Parker's world famous rise ball, along with other variations on pitching. Along with the technique will be instruction for drills, workouts, and strength and conditioning tips to train the well-rounded pitcher.

The catching portion of the clinic will feature separate instruction and training including framing, blocking, pick-offs, throw downs, pass balls, proper approach on short game/bunt defense, 1st and 3rd defensive strategy, calling the game/handling the pitchers, DRILLS, DRILLS, DRILLS for the development of a catcher, and much more.

Although the catchers will have the chance to catch the pitchers in attendance as part of their training program, it is highly recommended that each pitcher bring someone as a backup to catch them in the event there are not an even amount of catchers to pitchers (camp director will inform all pitching participants on the number of attending catchers closer to the time of the clinic). This can be a parent, brother/sister, family member, or other catcher not signed up for camp. A catcher **WILL NOT** be needed the whole time, only in the times toward the latter part of the day when the pitchers are given the opportunity to throw full out. In the extreme event there are not enough attending catchers or the pitcher cannot supply a catcher arrangements can be made through the camp director. **WE WILL make it work for the benefit of the attending athlete.**
