INTERNATIONAL SOFTBALL FEDERATION (ISF)
FEDERACIÓN INTERNACIONAL DE SOFTBOL

Umpires who meet the requirements below are eligible for ISF certification as "Continental Umpire". Continental Umpires will be assigned to umpiring at World Cup Championship level. Applications will be reviewed periodically, (see DEADLINES below) and notification to attend the "ISF Continental Umpire" Seminar in Plant City will be forwarded if approved.

A. EXPERIENCE FOR ISF CONTINENTAL LEVEL:

1. Must have umpired in at least one (1) national or regional championship, in the same category and division of play in which the applicant is applying. See breakdown below:

Reg/Nat Championship – Qualifies to umpire

B. VERIFICATION

1. Must be a current registered and active member of the ASA umpire program. Must be in good standing with the local association.
2. The state/metro commissioner where the umpire is registered, must sign the application.

NOTE: Verification should not be made by the commissioner, if items A-B/1-4 under EXPERIENCE are not achieved.

C. EXPENSES

All expenses incurred while attending an ISF Seminar (travel, housing, meals, etc.) are to be paid by the applicant. (See also items 3-5).

D. PROBATIONARY OR INACTIVE STATUS

Any conduct by an umpire unbecoming of the standards of the ISF "INTERNATIONAL" or "CONTINENTAL" umpire (on or off the field) could result in that individual being placed on probationary status.

E. ASSIGNMENTS

An umpire may be approved in more than one (1) category of play (Fast Pitch, Slow Pitch, or Modified Pitch), but must attend and pass a seminar for each category to be approved.

An umpire approved in one category (fast, slow, or modified) at the "Continental" level cannot be assigned to Games in any of the other two categories. If approved in two categories, the umpire can be assigned in either.

F. APPLICATION FORM

1. Application forms may be obtained from the ISF office (1900 S. Park Road, Plant City, FL 33566-8113, Tel. 1-813-864-0111) or the ASA office (2801 NE 50th St., Oklahoma City, OK 73111-7203, Tel 1-405-425-3446).
2. Only current application forms will be accepted.
3. The applicant and the State/Metro Commissioner, must sign the application form.
4. Applications which do not have the required signatures or do not meet the qualifications outlined under experience, will be returned with the application fee.
5. The application must be accompanied with a \$50 fee. This will be refunded if the applicant does not qualify to apply for Seminar. If received past a deadline, the applicant will be notified that the fee and application will be held until the next Seminar.

G. PHOTOS

Applications must include three (3) passport size photos attached.

H. DEADLINES

Applications will be accepted year round. Seminars are planned annually in Fast Pitch, Slow Pitch, and Modified Pitch. Notification of acceptance will allow plenty of notice to make plans to attend. Separate seminars will be held for each category.
